If a student earns D, F, or WF in the prerequisite course, the student MUST repeat the prerequisite course (and must meet placement requirements for that prerequisite). Entry into the next course by way of a placement test is not an option in this case.

In other words, a grade less than C in the prerequisite course trumps any placement score.

## Note:

For many majors, Math 101 satisfies the math requirement and college algebra isn't required. However, if students are required to take College Algebra (106/108), but don't place into College Algebra, they will be required to complete a free online "prep for Math 106" course prior to Jan. 10th (for spring) and Aug. 10th (for fall). The prep course is self-paced (can take 10-30 hours depending on math level) and there are several ways to earn the mastery points required. The course for the fall opens June 1<sup>st</sup> – but students can enroll anytime prior to the end of July. However, students that don't enroll early, might not finish. The course for the spring opens Nov. 1<sup>st</sup>. If completed by the deadline, a student will be allowed to take Math 106 (College Algebra Enhanced). If students do not finish by the deadline, they will need to repeat entire prep course during the next session it is offered prior to enrolling in Math 106.
