- 1) Beginning Spring 2020, SIUC no longer offers Intermediate Algebra Intermediate Algebra. However, if you have taken an Intermediate Algebra course at another college or university that transfers to SIU with a C or better within the last two years, you will be permitted to register for a course in which Intermediate Algebra is a prerequisite. However, the free prep for Math 106 course is recommended (but not required). Contact mathplacement@siu.edu to be enrolled. This course will help you prepare for college level math.
- 2. For many majors, Math 101 or 102 satisfies the math requirement and college algebra isn't required. However, if students are required to take College Algebra (106/108), but don't place into College Algebra, they will be required to complete a free online "prep for Math 106" course prior to Jan. 10th (for spring) and Aug. 10th (for fall). The prep course is self-paced (can take 10-25 hours depending on math level) and there are several ways to earn the mastery points required. If completed by the deadline, a student will be allowed to take Math 106 (College Algebra Enhanced).

If a student earns C-, D, F, or WF in the prerequisite course, the student MUST repeat the prerequisite course (and must meet placement requirements for that prerequisite). Entry into the next course by way of a placement test is not an option in this case.
